



Prevention & management of “Can’t Intubate, Can’t Oxygenate” events: Provider training course

Overview

Full day course addressing knowledge and skills required to deliver education around the prevention and management of “Can’t Intubate, Can’t Oxygenate” (CICO) events.

Target Audience

This course is relevant to consultant anaesthetists and advanced anaesthetic trainees

Description

Aims

To develop skills to run CICO education using immersive simulation, technical skills workshops and video-triggered discussions

Topics covered

The course focuses on teaching the following topics

- Human factors in airway management
- Vortex Approach to optimise upper airway rescue
- Concept of “transition” to CICO rescue
- Communication and teamwork during difficult airway management
- The Royal Perth Hospital CICO algorithm
- CICO Rescue techniques
- Delivering CICO training: teaching techniques, equipment, props, resources, etc

Topics not covered include: Wet-lab training techniques; advanced debriefing/simulation instruction; Assessment.

Approach

- Participants will work in small groups with instructors experienced in both clinical simulation and CICO training.
 - The focus on the day will be practice and feedback using part-task trainers, manikin simulators
- Maximum Participants

Consultant or advanced trainee level.
